1. INTRODUCTION TO OUR USE OF 'COOKIES' AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGY

Like almost every other online service, our Services (including our website and app) use cookies and similar technologies to provide you with an enhanced user experience as well as allowing us to analyse and improve our Services. We would not be able to provide you with all of our Services, including certain personalised features, without the use of cookies and related technology and as such, your computer, mobile phone, tablet or other enabled mobile device (which we refer to collectively in this policy as a "device") will need to be set up to enable such technologies.

2. WHAT DO WE MEAN BY THE TERM 'COOKIES'?

Cookies is a term used to describe a small text file (typically made of letters and numbers) that is downloaded and stored on your browser or your device by websites that you visit. They are sometimes considered as forming part of the "memory" of your use of websites and related services as they allow service providers to remember you and respond appropriately.

3. WHAT COOKIES DOES BILDERLINGS USE?

Bilderlings uses the following categories of cookies:

Strictly necessary cookies - these are the cookies that are required for the necessary operation of our Services and are always on. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website and/or app.

Performance cookies - They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

Functionality cookies - These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

Targeting or 'tracking' cookies - These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information

to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

4. MANAGING COOKIES

You can manage your cookies (including the enabling or disabling of cookies) through your browser settings. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including cookies that are strictly necessary) you may not be able to access all or parts of our Services. Please also note that deleting browser cookies can remove your opt out preferences, so you may need to opt out again.

Each browser is different and as such we suggest that you check the 'Help' menu on your particular browser (or your mobile phone's handset manual) to learn how to change your cookie preference. You may also find more information on how to manage your cookies from third party websites (such as <https://www.aboutcookies.org/>) as well as third party apps.

5. ONLINE BEHAVIORAL ADVERTISING
